Called to Order at 4:03pm

Agenda-Radtke moved to approve the agenda with the addition of the meeting schedule under New Business, supported by Anderson. Motion carries.

Consent Agenda-Komrska moved to approve the consent agenda, supported by Anderson. Motion carries.

Reports-

Airport Manager-Anderson reported on the 2 trees interfering from the glide slope need to be removed or sheared lower this spring. We could look into a shade pavilion or shade cloth to allow a shaded areas so we don't have to continue to deal with these same trees every few years. Anderson will check with Randy to see what he advises. Anderson is working on the possibility of hangars and the airport committee will meet to make a recommendation after he reaches back out to the interested parties. On runways 5/23 need to have the small brush cleared out so Anderson will coordinate that work bee. The fencing has been successful to deter the public from encroaching on airport property for dog walking and recreation.

Maintenance- Johnson reported that we can get started on the mats once the temps warm up a bit. Pierce inquired about maintaining the other field in the northwest corner between the 2 adult fields.

TRAMPS-Komrska reported that the lease was renewed by the township. Radtke reported several occurrences of vandalism at the entrance to the brush drop off.

Programming-Radtke reported Pierce's role as Parks/Rec Director, as well as the attempt to coordinate our league with the youth leagues at Civic Center South. Pierce reported he is working on contacting the leadership teams of the different leagues. He has been getting flyers out and will continue that. Info is on our website and he feels interest will peak as weather breaks. Anderson is willing to do the basketball clinics again this year. We hope to resurface the courts this year as well. Leedy reported on the softball program budget.

New Business-Grant Application to the Regional Health Department Camp Saki-Rotary Charities property acquisition was discussed in detail. Discussion ensued, questions answered with the Supervisor asking for any opposition: Consensus was no opposition. Consensus was in unanimous support. Komrska moved to support the grant application for the acquisition based on our parks and master plan, supported by Pierce. Motion carries unanimously.

Meeting Schedule-Komrska moved we move the meeting time at 6pm, supported by Pierce. Motion carries unanimously.
